

# BROOME HOUSING PROGRAM

## EXPRESSION OF INTEREST



Jalbi Jiya means “your home” in the Yawuru language. The Jalbi Jiya program will provide affordable rental housing, offering places for single Aboriginal parents. It will also provide the opportunity for Aboriginal families in Broome to realise home ownership in a supportive program.

### Eligibility criteria, applicants must:

- Be Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander
- Be a resident of Broome
- Be a first home buyer
- Provide a history of stable employment
- Engage with mentoring throughout the rental phase
- Meet with a registered lender
- Not be listed on the National Tenancy database for past bad tenancies or have an outstanding debt with Department of Communities
- Agree to program requirements including personal planning meetings and surveying
